

FORMAT (INTERNAL STRUCTURE) OF THESIS

The final format of the thesis containing the preliminary pages and the text pages should be organized in the following sequence:

- Title page
- Certification page
- Dedication
- Contents
- List of Tables
- List of Figures
- Abbreviations
- Acknowledgments

The preliminary pages should be followed by the main text. The main text may contain the following chapters:

	Note: Summary and Literature Cited should not be numbered as a Chapter.

Sample-2

In cases where a research topic dealing with different fields and demands a separate handling of different parts of the research, the main text may contain the chapters, appearing as a continues text in the following way:

Chapter 1	GENERAL INTRODUCTION
Chapter 2	RESEARCH ASPECT/FIELD (This chapter should consist of separate Abstract, Introduction, Review of Literature, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion)
Chapter 3	RESEARCH ASPECT/FIELD (The number of such chapters may be developed according to the requirements of research proposal but the last chapter should be General Discussion).
Chapter 4	GENERAL DISCUSSION
	SUMMARY
	LITERATURE CITED
	Note: Summary and Literature Cited should not be numbered as a Chapter.
